Using Media to Promote Health, Well-Being and Social Change

The event will focus on the importance of accurate information in the news and strategies to better understand the validity of news reports. In addition, projects utilizing media to promote health, well-being, and social change will be highlighted by experts from agencies and civil society examining how media and communication technologies can be used in various parts of the world. An entertainment education serial radio drama in Mozambique, which is carried on 70 radio stations, developed to improve the health and well being of children and adolescents, will be highlighted. The focus of the radio program is shifting public knowledge, attitudes, and behaviors around key health and education issues, such as girls' primary education, antenatal care, nutrition, child protection and HIV prevention. Journalists will also describe their stories to influence social change pertaining to health, trauma, and climate change.
